Plants perform well under both evergreen and hydrogen cyanamide management systems. Plants produce large, firm berries that have an excellent, persistent blue color. Plants return high season-long yields, and have consistently outperformed the current evergreen variety standard in central Florida. Plants of 'FL06-377' are susceptible to leaf rust (but do not drop leaves) and phytophthora root rot.
